Amendment no. 1 to the dean's measure no. 19/2009
regulating the supervision procedure of studies

Art. I

1. Article I point 1) is supplemented by the following paragraph which will be worded as follows:

In connection with the development of modern communication and electronic technologies and possibilities of misusing them as a unjustified advantage or benefit of the student within fulfillment of study duties in the form examinations, classified credits, credit tests, colloquiums and the like by which student's knowledge is verified and tested in the course of study, **the student is not permitted:**

- a) to use study aids such as books, textbooks, notes and similar text materials related to the subject of the above mentioned forms of examinations;
- b) to use any electronic, electro-technical equipment and components thereof, including computer technology enabling communication, data sharing, storage of data or text materials, connection with information systems, digital consumer products and the like;
- c) to use any reproduction, registration technology, cameras – including built-in cameras in mobile phones, video-cameras and other optical equipment, dictaphones, media players and other similar acoustic apparatuses.

Exception: The above mentioned technologies and equipment ensuring equal treatment with respect to passing the respective examination may be permitted to persons with health or physical disability. Assessment of the exception falls within the competence of the academic employee authorized to examine or a supervising employee of the First Faculty of Medicine of the Charles University.

These rules and conditions are binding for students of all years and forms of study. Any conduct of a student which will be in conflict with the present version will be considered a gross breach of the rules of study at the First Faculty of Medicine of the Charles University and a gross violation of the principles of medical ethics which might expose a student to disciplinary proceedings pursuant to the Act no. 111/1998 Coll., as amended.

2. The other provisions will remain unchanged

This amendment will come into force and effect on the day of signing hereof.
