

# WINTER SEMESTER 2020/2021 AT THE FIRST FACULTY OF MEDICINE OF THE CHARLES UNIVERSITY

## LECTURES



In connection with a directive issued by the Hygiene Station of the City of Prague valid so far until 31 October 2020, lectures take place only online. Online instruction will be centrally accessible from MS Teams-based faculty e-learning website (e-learning.lf1.cuni.cz).

Online classes will use faculty-supported communication and teaching platforms MS Teams and Moodle. In case any e-learning materials are placed on other platforms, links must be placed on the abovementioned faculty MS Teams and Moodle sites.

## SEMINARS



Seminars will take place online at time corresponding to in-person classes for individual study groups. Participation in online seminars remains compulsory.

In exceptional circumstances, seminars that include practical instruction may take place in person with at most 15 persons present.

## PRACTICAL EXERCISES AND CLINICAL INTERNSHIPS

Practical instruction (laboratory exercises, microscopy, simulation teaching, work with anatomical preparations, etc.) is limited to 10 persons being present in one room.

During practical instruction, preventive measures must be meticulously followed (nose and mouth covering, disinfection of hands and work surfaces). Adherence to these measures is the responsibility of the relevant teacher.

During clinical instruction, it is necessary to insure the lowest possible student/patient ratio, whereby the maximum number of students present in a room with patient/patients is 5. In case clinical instruction takes the form of excursion to a department/hospital, the maximum number of students is 20.

In case a student cannot, due to objective and serious reasons, participate in practical instruction (reasons are to be evaluated by subject guarantor), the student must make an arrangement for compensating for the instruction missed.

## EXAMINATIONS



We assume that in a vast majority of cases, examinations will take place in person. Examination may take place while at most 10 persons are present. Online examinations may be permitted in exceptional cases by subject guarantor. In case a student due to objective reasons cannot be personally present, even state examinations may take place online.

The procedure during online examinations is defined in and determined by a Dean's measure.

## OPTIONAL AND MANDATORY OPTIONAL SUBJECTS

Mandatory optional subjects are taught according to the same principles as mandatory courses: they may not be cancelled. Optional courses take place in accordance with the abovementioned instructions, too, but they may be postponed to the summer term.

## INSTRUMENTS OF COMMUNICATION

**SIS** – is according to current directives the primary information source. It contains binding information and students' valid emails. Institutes and departments must make sure that the SIS contains current and relevant information about them.

**MS Teams / Moodle** – newly recommended/mandatory platforms for the entire faculty. Each subject must make sure that links to all recommended sources are available on these platforms.

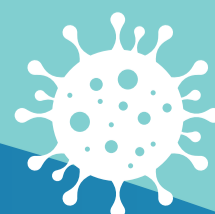
